8/31/2023 Project Update

- Contractor (KTE and their subcontractors) construction activity over the last week has included:
 - Ongoing grading and placement of topsoil;
 - Miscellaneous concrete curb & flatwork;
 - Adjusting castings;
 - Topsoil fine grading and final seeding;
 - Street, trail, and driveway bituminous paving; permanent signs, (primarily on Highland Scenic Road).
- Activities planned through the weeks of September 5th and 11th include:
 - Permanent street lights, final lift paving, signing, striping, final seeding, and tree planting on Cypress Drive and Douglas Fir Drive;
 - Miscellaneous minor paving;
 - Permanent street lights on Highland Scenic Road.
- WiDSETH and SEH (the City's consulting engineering team for the project) continue to be regularly on site observing Contractor construction progress. There has been

and will continue to be ongoing periodic survey crew activity by WiDSETH, installing wood lath with paint/ribbons. The private utility companies have been and will continue marking their buried facilities with flags and paint throughout the project. Please do not disturb the survey stakes and utility flags as they are necessary for assisting with construction activities and for safety.

8/31/2023 Traffic Control Update

- Per the PSA below and attached, Highland Scenic Road (CSAH 48) from approximately 100 feet east of Chestnut Drive to approximately 500 feet east of Berrywood Drive will be opening back up to traffic by noon on Friday, September 1st.
- The Berrywood Drive access to Highland Scenic Road will open on the same timeline.
- Cypress Drive between College Road and Highland Scenic Road (CSAH 48) is planned to remain closed to all traffic until construction is complete, currently estimated to be the end of September.
- Douglas Fir Drive south of Hastings Road and Hinckley Road between Cypress Drive and Douglas Fir Drive is currently only open to local traffic.
