9/8/2023 Project Update

- Contractor (KTE and their subcontractors) construction activity since the last update has included:
 - Highland Scenic Road (CSAH 48) officially being opened to on-road vehicular traffic on Friday, 9/1:
 - No work on Monday 9/4 (Labor Day);
 - o Topsoil fine grading and final seeding, and cleanup/re-seeding after Tuesday's rain;
 - Miscellaneous concrete work;
 - Tree planting;
 - Permanent signs.
- Activities planned through the weeks of September 11th and 18th include:
 - o Finish permanent street lights, permanent signs, final lift paving, final pavement markings, final seeding, and punch list work.
 - Paving is currently planned for the end of the week of September 11th, subject to change.
- The goal is to complete all construction work before the end of September.
- WiDSETH and SEH (the City's consulting engineering team for the project) continue to be regularly on site observing Contractor construction progress during active construction activites. There has been and will continue to be ongoing periodic survey crew activity by WiDSETH, installing wood lath with paint/ribbons. The private utility companies have been and will continue marking their buried facilities with flags and paint throughout the project. Please do not disturb the survey stakes and utility flags as they are necessary for assisting with construction activities and for safety. The Contractor, City, and

SEH/WiDSETH team have and will continue to be removing lath and utility flags when they are no longer needed.

9/8/2023 Traffic Control Update

- Highland Scenic Road (CSAH 48) is and will remain open to vehicular on-traffic
 - o Note, the trails at the roundabout are NOT open to the public yet.
- The Berrywood Drive access to Highland Scenic Road is open to traffic.
- Cypress Drive between College Road and Highland Scenic Road (CSAH 48) is planned to remain closed to all traffic until construction is complete, currently estimated to be before the end of September.
 - Note, the trails along Cypress Drive, and along and north from Hinckley Road, are also NOT open to the public yet.
- Douglas Fir Drive south of Hastings Road and Hinckley Road between Cypress Drive and Douglas Fir Drive is currently only open to local traffic; it is anticipated to fully reopen before the end of September.
