### 7/28/2023 Project Update

- The Prime Contractor (Anderson Brothers) has been continuing their dewatering operations on Clearwater Road for underground utility work in conjunction with the new trail.
- The City will continue to provide 48 hour notice to all properties that may be affected by water service interruptions (aka temporary water shut downs).
- The contractor continues to move west along Clearwater Road with underground utility work. Much of this work will take place outside of the roadway but portions of the work will require hard closure of the road to complete. The intersection of Clearwater Road and Green Briar Drive will be closed 8/1 to 8/3. See the attached PSA and Map for more information.
- By the end of today (Friday 7/28) the contractor will have completed reclaiming both Clearwater Road and Cedar Scenic Road, grinding up the existing pavement and leaving an aggregate surface passable to traffic.
- Private utility companies (electric, gas, communications) relocation work has been ongoing on and around the project limits and is anticipated to continue through July.
- SEH (the City's consulting engineer for the project) has been assisting the City monitor the private utility activities, observe Contractor construction progress, and respond to property owner questions. There has been and will continue to be ongoing periodic survey crew activity by SEH, installing wood lath with paint/ribbons. The private utility companies have been and will continue marking their buried facilities with flags and paint throughout the project. Please do not disturb the survey stakes and utility flags as they are necessary for assisting with construction activities and for safety.
- In the coming weeks the contractor will begin topsoil stripping and grading. If you have an irrigation system on your property please mark it and contact Paul Bremer to assist us and the contractor in minimizing damage to your system during construction.
- **Please remember that schedules can change at a moment's notice because of weather, delays by subcontractors, private utilities, breakdowns, or other unforeseen events.**

## 7/28/2023 Traffic Control Update

- The hard closure of Clearwater Road near the entrance of the Pine Grove apartments is no longer in place.
- The intersection of Clearwater Road and Green Briar Drive will be closed to all traffic from Tuesday August 1<sup>st</sup> through Thursday August 3<sup>rd</sup>. All residents will have access to their properties. See the attached PSA and map for more information.
- Following the Green Briar Drive closure another complete closure will be required on Clearwater Road between Inglewood Drive and Grand Oaks Drive. That closure is anticipated to be during the week of August 7<sup>th</sup>. More information will be provided in a future update.
